All children are required to have a **non-plastic boot bag**, for health reasons boots with no bags will be left outside under the shelter, we are happy for you to bring in and take home each forest school session, but children with no boots will not be able to attend forest school, sorry for the inconvenience this may cause.

Holiday Club is open to children from 3-7 years of age. Ladybird staff run activities throughout the day, and there's time for the children to unwind with a snack in front of
