Next Projects: Over the Easter holidays we'll be repairing our leaking shed and making some improvements to the Forest School space, including rebuilding the bird house. As you know, we have been raising funds this year to install some much needed air-con units in our building. The extra holiday clubs held in December and February added an additional £2,263 to the fundraising pot, and the Easter raffle raised a further £306 - thank you for supporting this! If monies raised from our holiday clubs and this year's other fundraising activities allow us to reach our target, we hope to install air-con during the May half-term.
